Thank you so much for all of your fundraising for the Lepra campaign. Every child in school spent a fun half hour session taking part in a Zumba session as a reward and it was fantastic to see so many of them all enjoying themselves! We are hoping to have a Zumba club available to everyone in school beginning after Christmas as we all loved it so much!

Many of you had worked hard to collect over £25 for Lepra which is amazing. I have read about some fantastic ways in which you did this and I am touched by your kindness.
