**\*\*Pupils who attend St Mary's Roman Catholic School or St Thomas' Church of England School shall for these purposes attend the secondary school for the area in which they permanently reside.**

**\*\*\*Pupils transferring from the Bunscoill Ghaelgagh whose parents wish them to continue with an element of Manx medium learning are for these purposes, regarded as residing within the catchment area of the Queen Elizabeth II High School, Peel, irrespective of the parents' actual place of permanent residence, provided that the pupil has been in attendance at Bunscoill Ghaelgagh for more than one year, prior to attaining secondary school age.
