## FOMS

FOMS have been working hard to raise money to improve our school and we have numerous projects in the pipeline. The next one is going to begin in the coming few weeks! We will be developing the wildlife and Solar Dome area to make it an accessible learning space all year round. We are starting by having a concrete path running from the playground up to the Dome. This will enable the children to be able to access it in all weathers which will make it more usable.

The Dome will then be sealed to make it watertight so it can be used for quality learning experiences. The school council have voted to paint the floor in there light blue and we will then set it up with a heater/ fan so the temperature will be suitable in all seasons.

FOMS are also going to be providing us with funds to create and establish 6 new vegetable beds which the children will be using to grow their own produce throughout the year. These are being built over the next month so will be ready to go as soon as possible! This will enable our children to understand the many benefits of growing our own produce.

Whilst the different works are completed, please ensure your child does not go into the Wildlife area after school so that they are safe, thank you for your co-operation.
